FPA received a payment of \$460k from Verizon.</li> <li>Staff productions income is up, office suite rental income is up, salaries/benefits/taxes are down, facilities expenses are up \$6k, office operations expenses are down \$69k, internet expenses are up, prepaid expenses are up \$7k, fixed assets are up, and the loan payable building is down \$84k.</li> <li>The comparison budget should be around 25% on the income and expenses side, and FPA is within that range.</li> <li>Fee for service and staff productions are up, and the net training income is up.</li> <li>Steve M: The last payment was made on the mortgage for the building on 9/28.</li> </ul>
Executive Director	Chuck Pena	- Cox has paid FPA the above noted \$120,652.76, (which represents payment of \$96,031.45 for unpaid PEG Grants plus \$24,621.31 interest). The PEG grant underpayments were discovered as a result of an audit conducted by an outside firm engaged by the County. After reviewing the results

	of the audit the County filed a law suit against
	of the audit, the County filed a law suit against Cox, which was subsequently dropped after Cox agree several conditions, including the interest payment amounts, which represent an interest rate equal to that which the federal government charges for late tax payments. -FPA participated in Hispanic Heritage Month with special programming celebrating Hispanic Heritage, and sent out two press releases. FPA is continuing to build a favorable reputation with Ch. 9 News Reporter Peggy Fox, who described FPA Spanish language movies, based on classic novels as fantastic. Further, Fairfax County School Board representatives were extremely supportive as this programming and worked to promote it, including sending the press release to school principals to share with teachers. - Verizon's announced "Over the Top" (OTT) video service will be delayed until at least the Spring of 2018, and possibly longer. Verizon cites a confluence of factors in this delay. As reported to the Board last month, Verizon is planning an OTT video service, which will deliver video programming via internet protocol, rather than as a tradition cable service. As noted last month, Chuck's position is that if any Verizon company offers video services in Fairfax County, those revenues should be subject to the PEG fees which fund FPA. The franchise agreement is with Verizon Virginia. The OTT service will be provided by Verizon Enterprises. -At the last board meeting, an action item was proposed to strengthen language stating that members could not view pornography on FPA's network. Chuck thinks that the current verbiage in the Operations Manual, approved by the Board
